


The tale of Drapers Bridge


17-21 Hounds Gate was built for James Snook & Co, drapers and haberdashers. In 1869, after almost a century's trading, it became a partnership, Snook & Durrant, specialising in linen from Manchester.

In 1881, the company extended onto the north side of the street and shortly after Snook bought out his partner, returning the business to its original name. By 1891 it was one of Nottingham's largest companies, and had replaced the existing buildings with those standing today.

James Snook died in 1910 and the striking bridge (known locally as the Bridge of Sighs) linking the buildings was added by Herbert D Snook in 1923. The company closed in the 1960s and its premises became offices – until now.

Bust The city's main bus terminus, Broadmarsh, is just 5 minutes' walk away, with many more stops just moments from your door.

Cycle: Drapers Bridge is conveniently situated on the city's bike lane network. Nottingham Citycard Cycles are located throughout the city, your nearest being Friar Lane.

Walk: Less than 1 minute away, you'll find independent cafés, restaurants, tea rooms and bars. The Old Market Square, the centre of the city, is less than 5 minutes' walk from your front door.

Fly: East Midlands Airport is just a 30-minute drive from the city and has direct flights to 90 international destinations.

Work: Walk to work, ride your bike or catch the tram. Alternatively, use a City Car, a cost affective, hassle free greener alternative. Conveniently located throughout the city.

Second floor


